TSA Application

You can access the TSA Alien Flight Student Program website to complete an application for clearance for flight training using the following link:

The FAQs (Frequently Asked Questions) will provide you with much of the information you will need. The first thing you should do is establish a User ID and Password to enable you to go in and out of your new application. This will establish your identity with TSA and a permanent record of all of your training events will link to this ID. If you have previously created a User ID and Password, enter that information to begin your application for this training event. When you have completed your application, please do not forget to click on Verify and Submit Application so your application will begin processing.

For initial type rating training you must have a student ID number assigned to you by Higher Power Aviation (HPA) in order to train at HPA. Please contact us at info@jetcrew.com to obtain a student number. For recurrent training, you will need the same information but are not required to list your student ID number. HPA will assign you one anyway for our tracking purposes. You must select Higher Power Aviation as your training provider in order for us to see your application. You will also be required to enter the following information to complete your TSA Category 1 or 2 application:

1. Your HPA student ID number (assigned to you by HPA).
2. The name of the course (Will be the type of aircraft such as: B727, B737, MD80, plus the words Type Rating Course; for example: B737 Type Rating Course).
3. The description of the course (This will be the same as the name of the course).
4. The course ID number. (This will be the aircraft only. You will be sent this information along with your HPA student ID number).
5. Your training dates.

Candidates will need to submit their personal information: name, citizenship, document information, addresses, and employment, prior to a flight training provider being able to validate or submit the training request. If requesting recurrent training, you must list the type rating for the recurrent training that you want to attend; otherwise your application will not be selectable by HPA for recurrent training for that aircraft. **NOTE: You must upload copies of your passport and airman's certificate. Please be aware that you must enter your name on the TSA application exactly as it appears on your passport. You must upload a very clear scanned image of your passport and the front and back of your pilot license. If the information you enter does not match your passport or pilot license, or if either document is not clearly legible, your application will be delayed. TSA will read your pilot license to verify that you hold the type rating for the aircraft for which you are requesting recurrent training.**
